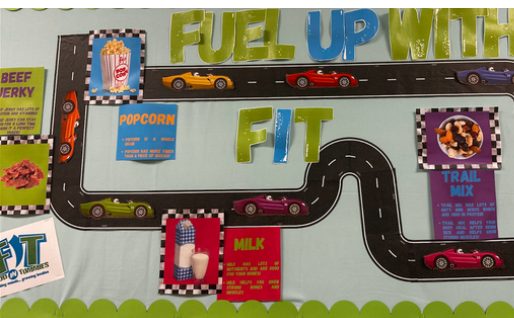

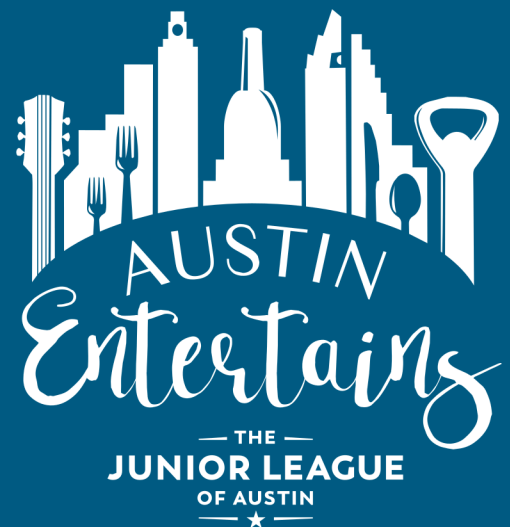

Food In Tummies

The Food In Tummies (FIT) program provides weekend nourishment to children in economically disadvantaged communities. JLA supports almost 1000 students in the Del Valle Independent School District. FIT's weekly food bags also include nutrition education and recipes in both English and Spanish.

Coats for Kids

Coats for Kids is an annual community project that collects and distributes more than 30,000 coats to eligible children and teenagers in Central Texas. Each year, The Junior League of Austin, Jack Brown Cleaners, iHeartRadio and KVUE partner to bring the community together to ensure the children of Central Texas stay warm.
