The Junior League of Austin Announces 4th Annual Bunny Brunch 2019 Ticket Sales

The popular family event raises money for The Junior League of Austin, including its newest signature program KICS – Kids In Cool Shoes.

This family-friendly event is scheduled from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. The day's activities include photos with Wendel the Bunny, a petting zoo, face painting and crafts, as well as live entertainment. Crafts include a chance for kids to plant their very own seedling in an egg crate to take home. The grand finale will be the egg hunt amongst the rolling green hills of the UT golf course.

All funds raised through this event will benefit The Junior League of Austin's signature programs, including KICS – Kids in Cool Shoes, Coats for Kids, and FIT – Food In Tummies, plus more than 30 community partners. Sydney Hayslett, Bunny Brunch Lead, remarked, "Our goals for the event include being able to provide an entertaining social family event which is not only an excellent opportunity to fundraise, but also to allow exposure to the mission of The Junior League of Austin. I can't wait to enjoy the event with my family and show them what all of my volunteer hours away from them do for the community."

The tickets are \$50 for kids and \$65 for adults, all supporting JLA's mission. The ticket price includes a basket for each child participating in the egg hunt and an upscale brunch. The menu provided by The University of Texas Golf Club staff is kid-friendly, but there will be plenty of options for the adults including a coffee bar, mimosas, and
